6 ½ inch square wooden box

We will be painting Texas wildflowers, a cowboy and his girl using a dry brush technique.

Surface/Supplies included:

- 6 1/2" square wood box with separate 5" wood star.
- Pattern and photos.

Student Supplies to bring:

- Brushes: #2, #4 Filberts for dry brushing. (I use JoSonjas #3005 Sabelon filberts, or 3/8" filbert rake brush. (Silver Ruby Satin 2528S filbert grass comb.)
- Brush for stippling (JoSonja #2-3- Domed round blender #2 or #4.)
- #1 or #2 short liner for linework and strokes. (JoSonja # 1360 10/) or your favorite liner for details on faces.
- #4 flat and a larger flat.
- Stencil Brush.
- Tape.
- Small ruler.
- Container for wet palette,
- waxy palette,
- Small container for mediums.
- Chalk pencil.
